**BURSARIES: Financial support**

CAA offers a number of bursaries to support attendance at the annual conference by individuals with limited financial resources. Those attendees are typically professionals from non-western countries with less developed economies and students. Preference is given to those presenting a paper, poster, or workshop, or serving as an invited roundtable panelist.

The CAA bursary fund is derived from a small portion of each conference registration fee. The CAA2006 Fargo Organizing Committee will also provide a limited pool of additional bursary funds based on grant awards and sponsorship contributions.

The amount of the bursary awarded to any given individual will depend on how much money is available, the number of applicants, and the costs to be incurred by the attendee. At the very least, a bursary covers the amount of the conference registration fee, with some additional funds also possible.

Accounting will be handled at the conference venue. Whenever possible, bursary funds for registration will be automatically paid to the Conference Organizers. Those with confirmed bursary will be asked to present their letter of award at registration.
