Dear CAA Colleague,

In the previously posted guidelines for submitting papers for the CAA2006 Proceedings, I indicated that the review of manuscripts would begin July 7. I did not set that as a deadline, although I had left that a bit vague in the hope that most people would in fact get their papers in by that date. The July 7 date was selected because it will give the editors and reviewers time to read papers before the next academic term begins and other time demands are more pressing. At the same time, however, I know full well that many people will be in the field through much of the summer, so they will have a difficult time meeting that date. Therefore, I did not state July 7 as a deadline, but left it as an intentionally vague target date.

Our intent is to work with contributors as much as possible to accommodate everyone's interests. In that light, I encourage you to submit your paper as near to the July 7 date as possible, but if more time is needed, please contact me with an estimated completion date. Please try not to go beyond early-to-mid August, and contact me if you are submitting late or have questions.
